Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 43 of Harris County, Texas, will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **Tuesday, September 8, 2026 at 6:30 P.M., at 23703 Lady Capulet Dr., Spring, Texas 77373** to consider and take action upon the following matters:

1. Tour the wastewater treatment plant located at 23703 Lady Capulet Dr., Spring, Texas 77373.
2. Call the meeting to order at the District's building, located at 23703 Lady Capulet Dr., Spring, Texas 77373.
3. Hear comments from District residents.
4. Hear Constable's security report.
5. Review reports of the bookkeeper including the budget, tax assessor/collector, and delinquent tax attorney, and authorize any necessary action.
6. Discuss the November 2026 Director's election, and take necessary action, including the following:
 - a. adopt Order Cancelling Election and Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office;
 - b. accept Certificate of Secretary Regarding Status of Unopposed Candidate;
 - c. accept Sworn Statement, Oath of Office and Official Bond of Re-elected Directors;
 - d. reorganize the Board of Directors, if necessary, and elect officers;
 - e. authorize filing of District Registration Form and submission to TCEQ.
7. Operator's report:
 - a. connection activity;
 - b. regulatory matters (permitting, subsidence);
 - c. water production and accountability;
 - d. billing, collections; and collection agency issues;
 - e. delinquent accounts;
 - f. operations, maintenance, and repairs of District facilities; and
 - g. manhole investigations.
8. Review engineer's report and take any necessary action concerning on-going construction within the District:
 - a. consider pay estimates;
 - b. authorize additional construction bid advertisement if necessary, and if timely;

- c. award contracts on additional District improvements;
 - d. consider any change orders; and
 - e. discuss engineering services and take any necessary action in connection with engineering matters.
9. Hear report from Treschwig Joint Powers Board ("TJPB") representative and review the meeting minutes of September 2026.
10. Hear report from North Harris County Regional Water Authority ("NHCRWA") representative and review minutes of September 2026 meeting.
11. Hear report from Yellowstone regarding maintenance and upkeep of drainage facilities and authorize any necessary repairs or improvements.
11. Discuss and consider approval of contract for landscaping services.
12. Discuss update on petitions for "No Overnight Parking of Commercial Vehicles" signs, including the number of signatures received from each section, and take any necessary action related thereto.
