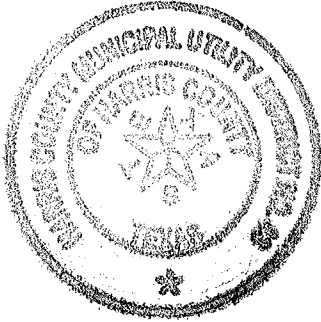

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 43 of Harris County, Texas, will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **TUESDAY, May 11, 2021 at 6:00 P.M.**, at the Birnamwood Clubhouse, 23803 Birnamwood Boulevard, Spring, Texas, a regular meeting place of the District, to consider and take action upon the following matters:

1. Tour new wastewater treatment plant.
2. Hear comments from District residents.
3. Hear Constable's security report.
4. Hear report from Christie Leighton of Best Trash regarding debris collection and other trash and recycling matters.
5. Review reports of the bookkeeper, tax assessor/collector, and delinquent tax attorney, and authorize any necessary action.
6. Operator's report:
  - a. connection activity;
  - b. regulatory matters (permitting, subsidence);
  - c. water production and accountability;
  - d. billing and collections;
  - e. delinquent accounts and timing for termination of accounts; and
  - f. operations, maintenance, and repairs of District facilities.

  - a. detention pond maintenance;
  - b. Phase II Parks Update; and consider approval of pay estimates, change orders and approval of contracts with Price Wagener Services; and
8. Hear report from Treschwig Joint Powers Board ("TJPB") representative and review the meeting minutes of May 2021.
9. Hear report from North Harris County Regional Water Authority ("NHCRWA") representative and review minutes of May 2021 meeting.

  - a. Discuss potential annexations and take any actions, including approval of:
    - (i) Petition for Annexation of Land into the District
    - (ii) Petition for Consent to Annexation of Land into the District.
